NOTIFICATION

G.S.R. 9 : In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the methods of recruitment to the post of Administrative Officer/Assistant Chief Accounts Officer in the Narcotics Department, namely;

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

NUMBER OF POST CLASSIFIC TICH AND SCALE OF PAY:-

The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

METHOD OF RECRUITMENT, ACE LIFT AND OTHER MATTERS!

The method of recruitment, age limit qualification and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedul.

5. DISQUALIFICATIONS: - 10 Der : Col.

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who having a shouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Central Government, may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other patty to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. POWER TO RELAX: -

Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of thes rules with respect of any class or category of person.

7. SAVING:-

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxations of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special (ategories of Persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
